This can result in screen reader users missing information in the cookie banner. A screen reader may read a close button inaccurately in the Preference Center.

This restricts access to this menu, although it can be worked around by reverse tabbing into the menu. Keyboard focus goes to the address bar on chrome after interacting with the banner. The focus should instead be on the first website element. This does not restrict access; it only
