## Keysight Technologies, Inc. Section 508 Position Statement

### 29 U.S.C § 794 (d) (Section 508) Accessibility Standards

The principle function of most Keysight products is to apply measurement technologies to sense, measure, analyze, and communicate physical phenomenon. These products are employed primarily in testing, manufacturing, research, and development environments. Because the principle functions of most Keysight products is not creation, manipulation, storage, display, receipt, or transmission of electronic data and information, as well as any associated content, these Keysight products are outside the scope of Section 508 compliance requirements.

Keysight offers some stand-alone software products and Web based portals subject to Section 508 when purchased by or for a United States Federal Agency. Keysight will provide an accessibility report for these products upon request if one is available.

Keysight also offers products that monitor telecommunications operating environments, which may be subject to Section 508 compliance when purchased by or for a US Federal Agency. Depending upon how they are used, these products may qualify under E202.5 of Section 508 exempting compliance requirements for status indicators and operable parts for Information and Communication Technology (ICT) functions located in spaces frequented only by service personnel for maintenance, repair, or occasional monitoring of equipment. Notwithstanding the possible exception, if an accessibility report is available for such products, Keysight will provide it upon request.
